

Proclamation

SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY IN THE BOROUGH OF WYOMING

WHEREAS, a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency was enacted by the Office of the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on January 23, 2026; and

WHEREAS, said Proclamation included the residents of Luzerne County; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wyoming is under imminent threat of a severe winter storm; and

WHEREAS, this storm has the potential to cause significant impacts to the public; and


NOW THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me in the Wyoming Borough Code, Part 9 § 15-901, I hereby declare a State of Snow and Ice Emergency.

FURTHER, all terms and conditions of the Wyoming Borough Code Part 9 §15-902 Regarding Parking Prohibited, Driving Motor Vehicles Restricted on Snow Emergency Routes during Emergency shall be implemented and penalties pursuant to Wyoming Borough Code Part 9 §15-904 shall be enforced.

AND FURTHERMORE, I hereby direct the Wyoming Borough EMS Coordinator, the Wyoming Area Regional Police Chief, and Wyoming Borough Street Commissioner of the Borough of Wyoming to employ any temporary workers, rental of equipment, purchase of supplies, materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

AND FURTHERMORE, this declaration shall be in effect for FOURTEEN (14) DAYS, or until rescinded or extended.
