

ORDINANCE NO. 1 of 2024

WHITE HAVEN BOROUGH, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHITE HAVEN BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES AT CHAPTER 18, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, PART 4, PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTION 404, PARKING PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS, CERTAIN DAYS AND HOURS

Whereas, the Borough Council of the Borough of White Haven contracts with a third-party hauler for refuse collection in the Borough; and

Whereas, logistical difficulties have been reported to Borough Council in connection with refuse collection on streets where off-street parking of vehicles blocks collection of curb-side refuse pickup in front of residences; and

Whereas, it has been determined that the most effective way to remedy these difficulties with collection is to limit off-street parking on certain streets during the days and hours of refuse collection.

Therefore, it is hereby Ordained that, Appendix II-C, which is incorporated by reference into and made a Part of the White Haven Borough Code of Ordinances in Chapter 18, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 4, Parking Regulations, Section 404, Parking prohibited in Certain Locations, Certain Days and Hours, is amended as follows:

Parking Prohibited in Certain Locations Certain Days and Hours

	Street	Side	Between	Days	Hours
1	Main Street	both	Susquehanna Street and alley	Every day	2:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.
2	Northumberland St	even	Church Street and SR 940	Monday	6:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

It is further Ordained that, the parking prohibited on both sides of Main Street between Susquehanna Street and the alley, every day from 2:00 AM to 7:00 AM is hereby **Repealed**.


This amendment shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


