Power Plan Implosion September 22, 2023

What you need to know

- The implosion will occur on Friday, September 22nd, 2023, as soon after 8 AM as safety and preparations permit.
- Street Closures (barring any unforeseen problems:
 - Pittsburgh Street (Freeport Road) will be completely closed from Murrayhill Ave in Cheswick to Colfax Street in Springdale Borough between 6:30AM-7:00AM until 11:00 AM.
 - Side streets will be closed in the area at 5:30AM
- Signs will be posted at the closures indicating alternative routes and uniformed police will also be on hand to assist and direct the motoring public accordingly.
- An exclusion zone will be set up around the site to prevent people from getting too close. We ask that you please cooperate with police and safety officials.
- A **small amount of explosives** will be used to demolish the Boiler House Building. Residents in the area may see dust, will hear noise, and may feel vibrations.
- Following the implosion, experts evaluate if changes have occurred using a pre-demolition photographic survey, vibration monitoring records, and will also complete pre/post-survey reports that are submitted to the state.

Please note: Although this implosion will produce noise, vibrations, and dust. This will not be as dramatic as the demolition of the smokestacks on June 2, 2023. Officials are taking extreme caution for everyone's safety.
