



CITY OF LATROBE POLICE DEPARTMENT CAPTAIN POSITION DESCRIPTION

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Police Captain is a managerial employee of the City of Latrobe Police Department. The captain assists the Chief of Police in the supervision of all subordinate police supervisors, police officers, community service officer, and the police secretary. The captain will assist in the investigation and necessary discipline of all subordinate supervisors and officers. The captain will provide assistance in planning, directing, and the administration of the Police Department. The captain is the first level supervisor for the subordinate supervisors. In the absence of the Chief, the Captain assumes the duties of the Chief and will coordinate all functions within the Department.

REQUIRED SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Working knowledge of Microsoft Office software including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Outlook, as well as, police department informational software, GIS software and use of radios, scanners, and other related technology.

Language Skills:

Ability to read, analyze, and interpret general business periodicals, professional journals, technical procedures, governmental regulations, and intelligence reports.

Ability to solve problems and manage emergency crises while exhibiting calm and controlled composure.

Ability to define problems, collect data, verify, and establish facts, and draw valid conclusions.

Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form and to explain them to others in a clear understandable manner.

Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of situations where only limited standardization exists.

Demonstrates integrity and ethics and always maintains confidentiality.

OTHER SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Thorough knowledge and ability to apply effective supervisory techniques, including recruitment and performance management and ability to command employees and to assign, direct, and supervise their work.

Maintains and displays a thorough knowledge of the application of criminal and applicable civil statues and ordinances including revisions and relevant court decisions affecting same.

Maintains an operational knowledge of all Department Orders, Policies, and Procedures.

Able to establish a position as leader, coach, instructor, and communicator to subordinate officers and always strive to set an example of professionalism, maintaining a positive attitude, and excellent work habits.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Summary

As designated by the Chief of Police, directs, plans, manages, and coordinates activities and operations of the City of Latrobe Police department by performing the following duties personally or through subordinate supervisors.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

In the absence or at the designation of the Chief of Police, supervises and directs the operations of subordinate supervisors and patrol by assuming command of duty.

Provides subordinate supervisors and police personnel with instruction and coaching in the interpretation and implementation of criminal and civil statues and police department policy, procedures, and directives.

Ensures compliance with Department policy, procedures, and directives by observing, or participating in patrol operations. Documents and maintains all data and personnel actions and information necessary to take appropriate disciplinary action in accordance with policy and procedures and the CBA.

Assists the Chief of Police with preparation of all training and work schedules for all Police Department personnel to maintain minimum levels of staffing, while ensuring that all contractual and training obligations are met.

Maintains the confidential personnel files of all Department employees whose positions are subordinate to this position.

Assesses and evaluates the qualifications and performance of the members and employees of the Department under his/her command as presented by subordinate supervisors, acknowledges success, and makes recommendations for improvement as required. Prepares reports to the Police Chief on the outcome of these actions.

Reports to the Police Chief all cases of misconduct or neglect of duty observed or coming to his/her attention involving any employee of the Department, documents accordingly, and follows up as directed.

Investigates and handles minor internal issues and disputes. Prepares reports to the Police Chief on the resolution of these items.

Responds to citizens' complaints of misconduct against officers and inquiries regarding department operations and policies. As designated by the Chief of Police, directs investigation of citizen complaints regarding officer misconduct or other alleged wrongdoing.

Provides consultation and assistance to the Chief of Police, City Manager, Mayor, and City Council, pertaining to the application of discipline.

Assists the Chief of Police and subordinate supervisors in the preparation of department policy manuals.

Assists the Chief of Police in preparation of the department's budget, participates in short- and long-range planning.

When assigned by the Chief of Police and in agreement with the CBA, performs all the essential patrol functions of a police officer.

Provides consultation and assistance to the Chief of Police, City Manager, City Council, and other governmental officials pertaining to the application of discipline.

As designated by the Chief of Police, directs the selection, supervision, training, development, and discipline of department personnel.

As designated by the Chief of Police, acts as the Departmental official to meet with a variety of community stakeholders and organizations to promote department goals and activities to develop positive community relations.

In the absence of or as designated by the Chief of Police, takes command of the police force during emergencies, such as critical incidents, fires, and civil unrest.

As designated by the Chief of Police, prepares, reviews, and presents reports and other necessary correspondence to the Chief of Police, City Manager, City Council or necessary stakeholders.

NON. ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provides support to patrol operations by coordinating the maintenance and repair of Departmental vehicles, equipment, and facilities.

Other non-essential duties as assigned or required.

Experience and Training:

Fifteen (15) years' experience in the criminal justice field or equivalent combination of education and experience in an administrative law enforcement position.

Ten (10) years advanced, or specialized field experience in the criminal justice field or equivalent combination of education and experience in an administrative law enforcement position.

Possesses and maintains current ACT 120 certification.

Possesses and maintains a valid Pennsylvania driver's license.

Possesses and maintains first aid and CPR certifications.
