AMENDMENT TO THE CITY CODE CHAPTER 319 TITLED SOLID WASTE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 319 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF LATROBE, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA- TITLED SOLID WASTE - ADDING SECTION 319-5 (F)

WHEREAS, the City of Latrobe maintains the city code Chapter 319 titled Solid Waste also known and referred to as the Municipal Solid Waste Ordinance of Latrobe which includes activities, standards, regulations, collection of fees, enforcement, violations and penalties for Solid Waste in the City of Latrobe which was originally adopted on April 23, 1996; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend the Code specifically Chapter 319-5 adding a section titled (F) to mandate rules for timing and placement of waste containers; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to also limit the number of stickered bags that can be placed weekly for trash to six bags.

WHEREAS, the City is supportive of efforts to keep the city maintained in good order; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the City of Latrobe, and the City of Latrobe hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 319-5 Section (F) be added as follows: The City authorizes that waste containers must be removed from the curbside by 9:00 p.m. on the day of collection. Waste containers, bags, and recycling containers should be placed for pick up on the evening prior or by 6 a.m. on the morning of pick up.

Section 2. That all other provisions of Section 319 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That the within Ordinance shall take effect on the date of publication of the post enactment notice of passage of the same and no later than June 1, 2026.

Section 4. That the City Manager, The City Secretary, Mayor and any other proper City official is authorized and directed to execute any and all documents and to take any action necessary in order to carry in effect the within ordinance.
