Join the Allegheny Township Staff and Emergency Services on Friday June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025 from 12:00-3:00pm at 136 Community Building Road, Leechburg, PA 15656 to educate and outfit our youth in bicycle safety. The program is provided by the Injury Prevention Program at UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh.

The free helmet fitting and distribution will take place during the scheduled timeframe. Kids 13 and under can receive one (1) free helmet and must be present. Parents or guardians must have proof of residency available. Supplies are limited and will be filled on first come first serve basis.

Take advantage of the beautiful trails located within Allegheny Township and speak with our special guests from Armstrong Trails.

Keep in mind a few safety rules for bicycle riding:

- Always plan your ride!
- Keep a safe distance from pedestrians and cars!
- Follow traffic rules!
- Keep your bike in good repair with clean reflectors and/or a blinking light!
- Never assume others can see you!
- Ride with a friend or family member if possible!
- **Always wear a helmet!**
