Street Repaving

Resurfacing of Palmer Avenue and Robin Hood at drain repair area – The CFA (Commonwealth Financing Authority) LSA Cat 3 grant, in the amount of \$85,268, has been secured for this project with an estimated cost of \$145,000. The contract with Kinsley states the project must be completed by October 31.

Robin Hood Drive – Water Leak – The northern end of Robin Hood continues to undergo repairs by York Water Company with the oversight of our borough engineer.

Fall Leaf Collection

Pick up will be on Mondays beginning November 3 and ending December 5 weather permitting.

- Only leaves will be collected—no grass, branches or foreign objects.
- Please do not park near leaf piles.
- Bad weather may delay pick up.
- Leaves must be placed curbside **along the streets**, not to exceed 4 ft. high and 4 ft. wide.

Caring for our properties...

Snow removal is required per New Salem Borough Code. It requires all property owners to remove snow and ice from their sidewalks within 24 hours from the end of precipitation. Snow and ice must be removed to a width of not less than 30 inches to provide a clear path for pedestrian traffic.

If not removed, the borough may clear the area and bill the residents for the work. Snow and ice are not to be thrown into the street. For public safety please consider clearing fire hydrants.

Sidewalk and Curbs – Owners hold the responsibility to keep sidewalks clear and free of tripping hazards. According to the ordinance, shrubs must be trimmed to the **vertical plane of the edge of the sidewalk** and there must be a **head clearing of 8 feet**.

Please be proactive in this primarily for safety reasons. Secondly, it is costly for our codes enforcement officer to inspect, notify owners, and follow-up on properties that are unsafe.

Who to call...

I need to have a large item picked up with my trash?
You can just put it out with your trash. It may be helpful to call Penn Waste (717-767-4456) to make sure they have what they need to remove your item.

Who do I call for clarification on paying my sewer bill?
Call York Water Company for answers to your questions about your sewer bill or payment (717-845-3601). As a reminder your water bill account is different from your sewer bill.

Does the secretary have office hours?
Office hours are by appointment. Phone hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 - 4:30.

What do I do if I've found a stray dog?

If you find a stray dog, you should call 911. If you have the dog contained, they will contact our contracted dog service. That service will seek to find the owner or take it to a shelter. If the dog is not contained and appears dangerous, 911 will give you instructions.

Do I need a permit for my remodel?

It's always best to check with Zoning and Codes Officer Mike Hammers regarding permits. If something is built or remodeled out of code, there could be a costly correct. Better safe than sorry.
