#### **ORDINANCE NO. <u>155-2023</u>**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COOLBAUGH TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE AT CHAPTER 355 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF COOLBAUGH TOWNSHIP BY ESTABLISHING TIME DEADLINES FOR INACTIVE PLANS.

WHEREAS, Coolbaugh Township has previously ordained and enacted an ordinance entitled the Coolbaugh Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance found at Chapter 355 of the Coolbaugh Township Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, at Section 503(1) does authorize and enable the Township to include in its Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance provisions regulating the submittal and processing of plans; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Coolbaugh Township has determined that delays by a developer in submitting revised plans in a reasonable and timely manner results in inefficiencies and delays in final approvals; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Coolbaugh Township has determined that both municipalities and developers are held to a reciprocal good faith standard in addressing defects in a pending subdivision and land development plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, by the Board of Supervisors of Coolbaugh Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, that Chapter 355, Subdivision and Land Development, of the Coolbaugh Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

#### ARTICLE I.

Chapter 355, Subdivision and Land Development, of the Coolbaugh Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new Section 355-15.J. to read as follows:

§355-15.J. Any preliminary plan filed with the Township which has not been revised within six (6) months from the date of the last Township Engineer's review letter shall be deemed inactive and may be denied for failure to promptly process the plan in accordance with Township ordinances.

#### ARTICLE II.

Chapter 355, Subdivision and Land Development, of the Coolbaugh Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new Section 355-16.N. to read as follows:

§355-16.N. Any final plan filed with the Township which has not been revised within six (6) months from the date of the last Township Engineer's review letter shall be deemed inactive and may be denied for failure to promptly process the plan in accordance with Township ordinances.

#### ARTICLE III.

Chapter 355, Subdivision and Land Development, of the Coolbaugh Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new Section 355-17.K. to read as follows:

§355-17.K. Any minor subdivision plan filed with the Township which has not been revised within six (6) months from the date of the last Township Engineer's review letter shall be deemed inactive and may be denied for failure to promptly process the plan in accordance with Township ordinances.

#### ARTICLE IV. SEVERABILITY

It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that if a court of competent jurisdiction declares any provisions of this Ordinance to be invalid or ineffective in whole or in part, the effect of such decision shall be limited to those provisions which are expressly stated in the decision to be invalid or ineffective, and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall continue to be separately and fully effective. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section or part thereof, other than any part declared invalid, if it had advance knowledge that any part would be declared invalid.

#### ARTICLE V. REPEALER.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

#### ARTICLE VI. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.

Coolbaugh Township MCPC review #184-23

The Township of Coolbaugh is proposing amendments to its subdivision and land development ordinance concerning plan processing. Specifically, the amendments would establish a period of six (6) months from the time a plan is filed until it is deemed inactive and may be denied for failure to promptly process the plan.

The above mentioned amendments have been reviewed on the basis of generally accepted planning principles and the provisions set forth by the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (PMPC), as amended. The following comments are offered:

- 1. The proposed ordinance amendments are generally consistent with the PMPC, Act 247 of 1968, as amended, in terms of following required procedures.
- 2. It is recommended that the Township discuss establishing this standard with their solicitor to confirm that the specific time period for deeming a plan to be inactive is consistent with the PMPC.
- 3. It is recommended that the Township replace the "six month" period with "180 days" to improve clarity of the ordinance and procedure.
- 4. If any revisions are made to the proposed ordinance amendments, they must be resubmitted to the MCPC for review prior to adoption. This requirement was affirmed by the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Court in Hanover Healthcare Plus, Inc. v. Zoning Hearing Board of Penn Township 875 A.2d 1255 (Pa. Cmwlth 2005). It is recommended that the Township discuss this with their solicitor.
- 5. The Staff has reviewed the proposed ordinance amendments and recommends they be adopted subject to the above noted comments being satisfactorily addressed.

In an attempt to maintain a library of municipal ordinances, we request that any adopted ordinance amendments (Zoning, Zoning Map and SALDO) be sent to the MCPC within 30 days of enactment as specified in the PMPC.

Solicitor Armstrong stated that the Board of Supervisors agreed to and signed the agreement which outlined the tax split for the property located at 145 Market Way; part of which is in Mount Pocono Borough and part in Coolbaugh Township. The split for taxes on the building would be 50/50 and the tax on the land would be 65% Coolbaugh and 35% Mount Pocono. The county is not accepting the agreement that was previously signed and taken to the Monroe County Courthouse for filing by the Solicitor for the borough. Solicitor Armstrong stated that there are two things we can do at this time, the Township can collect the tax money and then cut a check to the Borough for their portion, or he stated that he can contact the county and try to get them to accept the agreement and issue the checks accordingly for taxes collected. The Board agreed that they would like Solicitor Armstrong to contact the county and try to get them to handle this instead of the township having to issue checks to the Borough.

• Discussion: Ms. Ruiz-Smith stated that this is the same situation as Pocono Manor, which is located within the boundaries of three different municipalities. Ms. Kelly asked what the county does about the Lowes in Mount Pocono stating that part of that is Coolbaugh Twp. and part is in Mount Pocono

Borough. Solicitor Armstrong will contact Monroe County Courthouse, discuss the situation, and try to get them to cut the checks to each municipality separately.

He stated that an example would be an emergency repair or replacement of a sign. Mr. Weimer asked if we are able to schedule a special meeting should something come up that we need to act on prior to the next scheduled meeting, being advised that as long as it is advertised that should not be an issue.

• Discussion: M. Wood stated that there should be a sign added to the intersection of Harvest Lane with Mr. Weimer stating that the location in the median that is being discussed is a PennDot road that is in Tobyhanna Township, and they would have to add it.

Marty Nicoll, Managing Director of Ideal Property Management was in attendance and expressed his concerns with the township policy for Short Term Rental Renewals, stating that permits were previously issued and now owners are being told that they have zoning violations, and their permits are being revoked. He stated that the properties are reserved, they are losing rental income, paying fines to Airbnb/VRBO, and having their ratings go down because they have to cancel reservations since they are not being issued their renewal permits. He asked that the Board consider changing the policy to allow for the property owner to remedy their violations without their permits being immediately revoked. Maybe the Board could consider a 60-day extension to allow for the issues to be resolved. Mr. Weimer stated that he will meet with the Township STR officers and discuss the concerns. M. Nicoll stated that they want to be good neighbors.
