LEAF/YARD WASTE COLLECTION

South Park Township has contracted with County Hauling for the collection and processing of leaf/yard waste on the following dates:

Saturday, November 2, 2024 Saturday, November 16, 2024 Saturday, November 23, 2024 Saturday, December 14, 2024

The program will be handled differently this year. Residents who wish to participate in the service must register online with County Hauling at <u>www.countyhauling.com/yard-waste-collection-program</u>. After completion of the online registration, residents will receive an email confirmation of their upcoming scheduled date. Reminder emails will also be sent 7 days and 24 hours prior to collection. Removal of items will occur between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on the collection day.

The following guidelines must be followed:

1. Items that will be collected include shrubbery, brush trimmings, tree trimmings, limbs, twigs, garden residue, and other vegetative materials.

Items placed in regular garbage or recycling bags <u>WILL NOT</u> be accepted. Dirt, rocks, mulch, grass
clippings, and mulch <u>WILL NOT</u> be collected. South Park Township is selling yard waste collection bags –
5 bags for \$4.00.

2. Items must be packaged in biodegradable bags or securely tied in bundles not to exceed 48 inches in length. Branches and limbs must be no more than 3 inches in diameter. Please make sure your items are placed at the curb prior to 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection date.

Yard Waste Collection Program Frequently Asked Questions

What is the cost of this program?

There is no additional cost to you. This service is provided with your trash service.

What will be collected as part of this program?

Shrubbery, brush trimmings, tree trimmings, limbs, twigs, and garden residue are the most common items.

Do these items need to be packaged a specific way?

Items must be packaged in biodegradable bags or securely tied in bundles not exceeding 48 inches in length. Branches and limbs must be no more than 3 inches in diameter.

Where do I place my items?

Place your items at the curb where your garbage is typically collected from.

Will the items be collected on my regular trash day?

No, you must complete the online registration and choose an available date. After completing the online registration form you will be emailed with instructions for your collection.

What time will my items be picked up?

Your items will be removed anytime between 6:00 am and 6:00 pm on your scheduled collection date.

Do I need to be present during the collection?

You do not need to be present. Please ensure that your items are clearly visible and have been placed out before 6:00 am on your scheduled date.

We will no longer be driving every street for these collections and anyone who is interested in participating **must register** through our website or by reaching out to our customer service team.

ACCEPTED

- Leaves, twigs, straw, pine needles
- Shrubbery trimmings
- Branches & Tree trimmings
 - 2 inches diameter or less
 - 4 feet long or less
- Wood ash
- Items must be contained or bundled
 - Reusable containers with handles
 - Paper yard waste bags
 - Compostable bags
 - Bundles tied with twine
 - Containers and bundles no more than 60lbs
- Christmas trees (seasonally)
 - Remove all decorations
 - No bag or container needed

NOT ACCEPTED

- Dirt, rocks, & gravel
- Litter or trash from yard
- Plastic items
 - Including but not limited to, flower pots, plant tags, empty mulch and soil bags
- Large limbs and tree stumps
 - Larger than 2 inch diameter
 - Longer than 4 feet
- Wrong containers
 - Materials may not be in recycling or trash containers without proper identification of the product
 - Materials may not be in plastic bags
- Piles not contained or bundled
