NOTICE OF INTENT TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT

The Municipality of Penn Hills hereby gives notice of its intent to purchase one Bandit Woodchipper and one 5 Ton Dump Truck for the curbside collection of leaf waste, compost maintenance and transporting compost to the Penn Hills Compost Site as a part of its Residential Recycling Program. Following the curbside collection of leaf waste in the fall and spring, the Public Works Department turns the leaf waste into compost with a tub grinder. The compost is then distributed to the community for ball fields, community gardens, and private use. The Municipality of Penn Hills is applying for an Act 101 Section 902 Recycling Grant to fund the purchase of the equipment listed above and is also applying to fund public education costs.
