Spotlight on Grants:

How is Dover Township Addressing a Historic Flooding Problem Through Grants?

Pine Road has historically been subject to flooding. Events like Tropical Storm Lee (2011), Hurricane Sandy (2012) and Hurricane Ida (2021) have led to property damages, resident displacement and placing emergency responders in harm's way to perform water rescues. See how the Township has been approaching this problem by pursuing grants to acquire properties through the FEMA/PEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds.

The Little Conewago Creek located at the border between West Manchester and Dover Township is the water source for the flooding on Pine Road. The Township has been working in coordination with the York County Stormwater Consortium and West Manchester Township to pursue funding to complete a floodplain restoration project that will proactively provide flood storage and nutrient reduction as required by the Chesapeake Bay Pollution Reduction Plan for York County.
