Things to Know about New Salem Borough

Open Burning – Open fires shall be **permitted ONLY on the second Saturday of each month** between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:00 pm. Burning on other days may result in action of the fire department and could include a fine. Open fires on these dates are subject to cancellation if a burn ban is issued. Recreation fires for food and leisure are acceptable. For details go to ecode360.com/7264833

Property Maintenance – ecode360.com/7264915

Grass and Weeds – Grass and weeds shall not go to seed or exceed 12" in height.

***Do not blow grass clippings in the streets as it is very unsafe for motorcyclists and bicyclists...
and it is illegal. ***

Accumulation of Junk – There shall not be an accumulation of junk, trash or rubbish.

Sidewalks – Please keep your sidewalks clear of debris and safe for pedestrians. Trees and shrubs shall not encroach the sidewalks. Head room should be at least 8 feet.

Storm Drains – New Salem Borough does not have a public works department to complete routine maintenance. **Please take the time to keep the street's storm drains clear** by your property.

PLEASE DO NOT PUT anything (leaves, grass, cigarette butts, garbage, etc.) into the storm drains.
