Please be advised that Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC ("Columbia Gas") plans to start some construction on its pipeline facility In York County/Codorus Township Starting on August 12 through October 15. 2025.

Columbia Gas is a wholly owned indirect subsidiary of TransCanada Pipeline USA Ltd. Its principal office is located at 700 Louisiana Street, Suite 1300, Houston, Texas 77002-2761.

This project may involve some or all the following activities: earth disturbance, the presence of workers and equipment, temporary noise and dust, the replacement and/or installation of above and/or below ground facilities, new or modified access road(s) and grading and excavation.

Columbia Gas anticipates the project will take place between **August 2024 and October 2024**. However, the project could take longer depending on external factors such as weather, and the scheduling of personnel and equipment. After the construction activities are completed, site restoration activities will commence.
