## DECLARATION OF SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY AND COLD WEATHER ADVISORY


WHEREAS, the National Weather Service has issued a Winter Storm Watch for Dauphin County located in Central Pennsylvania, from 10:00 PM on Saturday, January 24, 2026, through 1:00 PM Monday, 26, 2026 (hereafter "Adverse Weather Event"); and

WHEREAS, Middle Paxton Township is located in Dauphin County, where the Winter Storm Watch is in effect; and

WHEREAS, the Adverse Weather Event is imminent and threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property located in Middle Paxton Township; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the movement of traffic and to combat the hazards of snow and ice on the snow emergency routes (all Public Streets in Middle Paxton), the Emergency Management Coordinator and Township Manager may declare a snow and/or ice emergency. After such declaration, it shall be unlawful, at any time during the snow emergency, for any person to park a motor vehicle or to allow that vehicle to remain parked anywhere on any snow emergency route in Middle Paxton Township. This also includes boats, trailers, basketball hoops, or any item that will impede the removal of snow and ice from public streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Emergency Management Coordinator and Township Manager of Middle Paxton Township, based upon the above recitals and pursuant to Middle Paxton Township Ordinance #2016-05, does hereby declare the existence of a Snow and Ice Emergency in Middle Paxton Township. This Declaration shall take effect at 10:00 PM January 24, 2026, and remain in effect until 1:00 PM, January 26, 2026.
