ORDINANCE 2026-01—IPMC—INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE—Adopted 4/7/26 Regulates and governs the conditions and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures. Many sections have been re-written to adhere to other Borough Ordinances.

RESOLUTION 2026-07 Adopted 4/7/26—Appointed Lacy Harang to the Zoning Hearing Board.

RESOLUTION 2026-08 Adopted 4/7/26—Appointed Katharine Grafton as a member of Borough Council.

RESOLUTION 2026-09 Adopted 8/4/26—Proclamation of *Kindness Week Worldwide* - recommended for all municipalities.

UPDATE ON NOTTINGHAM VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT

By now everyone is aware of the new 52 single family home development occurring on the former Wright farm. The developer, J.A. Myers has submitted the final subdivision plan which was conditionally approved by Council on July 7, 2026.

They have been moving dirt for sometime and working on the infrastructure. A few items remain before home construction can begin. Also they replaced the deteriorated fencing along N. Main St with new white vinyl rail fencing.

Main access to the development will be via the extension of Friar Rd onto W. George St/Salem Rd.
