



Potential Dangerous Heat This Week

OVERVIEW:

- The first heat wave of the summer is expected this week.
- Expect several consecutive days with temperatures exceeding 90°F and heat index values possibly in the 100 to 105°F range.
- The prolonged nature of this heat wave may have cumulative adverse effects on vulnerable population exposed to the heat.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Hot temps begin Monday, with heat and humidity increasing Tuesday. The heat wave could potentially last into next weekend.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Cases of heat-related illness are possible if proper precautions are not taken.▪ Outdoor workers and individuals with pre-existing health conditions will be among those at risk.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A Heat Advisory has been issued for all of Central Pennsylvania and is in effect from 12 PM Tuesday through 8 PM Tuesday.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Exact temperature & humidity forecasts may change as the event approaches depending on the strength of the high pressure & whether any showers or storms develop.
