## Reminder: Deck Repairs This Weekend on NB I-81 (George N. Wade Memorial) Bridge Between Dauphin and Cumberland Counties

**Right** and center lanes to be closed between Enola/Marysville and Front Street exits; left lane to remain open

Harrisburg, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) announced today that a PennDOT maintenance crew in Dauphin County is scheduled to perform deck repairs in the northbound Interstate 81 (George N. Wade Memorial) Bridge spanning the Susquehanna River between Dauphin and Cumberland counties. Lane restrictions will be in place.

Weather permitting, this work will be performed from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Saturday, October 19, and Sunday, October 20. The right and center lanes of northbound I-81 will be closed between the Enola/Marysville and Front Street exit. The left lane will remain open.

This could cause delays. Travelers are advised to seek alternate routes.

Motorists should be alert and drive with caution through the work zone.
