

ORDINANCE NO. 01-26

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF INGLIS, FLORIDA, INCREASING  
THE RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL RECONNECTION FEE;  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Inglis, Florida operates a water system within the Town; and WHEREAS, pursuant to section 70-32(e) of the Town of Inglis Code of Ordinances, the Town Commission has reviewed the existing rate structure of the water system to determine the propriety of rates charged in connection with the administration of the water system; and NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Commission of the Town of Inglis, Florida:

SECTION 1. REVISION OF RESIDENTIAL WATER RATES:


Section 70-32 Charge or rate for water service of the Town of Inglis is hereby amended with the lived language as the ~~strike~~ through amends

(e). Reinstallation of meter and service; reconnection of service. Where a water meter has previously been installed on a property and subsequently removed for any reason by the town, reinstallation of the meter and reestablishment of water service shall require the payment of a \$100.00 reinstallation fee and the payment of all other fees attributable to a new service or a new customer on an existing service prior to installation of the meter and commencement of service. This shall not apply to installation of a new service where no prior installation of a meter had occurred, and which new service installation shall be subject to the connection fee set forth in (a) and (b), above, as applicable. Where the water service has been turned off by the town for any reason, reconnection of service shall require the payment of a ~~\$20.00~~ \$50.00 reconnection fee.




