791 Rodi Road Closure this Weekend in Penn Hills 1-376 Parkway East ramp closures this weekend

Pittsburgh, PA – PennDOT District 11 is announcing the closure of Route 791 (Rodi Road) in the Municipalities of Penn Hills, Allegheny County, will occur Friday night through Monday morning, June 27-30 weather permitting.

Milling and paving operations this weekend on Rodi Road between Maple Lane and Business Route 22 (William Penn Highway) from 9 p.m. Friday until 5 a.m. Monday will require several restrictions:

Complete closure of the Rodi Road between Maple Lane and Business Route 22 (William Penn Highway)

Complete closure of the eastbound I-376 ramp to Penn Hills/Rodi Road (Exit 81) Complete closure of the Penn Hills on-ramp to eastbound I-376

Additionally, a short-term full closure of the westbound I-376 ramp to Penn Hills/Rodi Road (Exit 81) will occur from 5 a.m. to 9 a.m. Saturday.

Traffic will be detoured.

Posted Detour

Rodi Road to Eastbound I-376

- From Rodi Road, take the ramp to westbound I-376
- Take the Churchill (Exit 79B) exit
- Turn left onto Beulah Road
- Turn left onto Churchill Road
- Turn left onto the ramp to eastbound I-376/Business Route 22
- End detour

Westbound I-376 to Rodi Road

- Take the Churchill (Exit 79B) exit
- Turn right onto Beulah Road
- Turn right onto Frankstown Road
- Follow Frankstown Road to Rodi Road
- End detour

Eastbound I-376 to Penn Hills/Rodi Road (Exit 81)

- Continue on eastbound I-376
- Take the Plum (Exit 84B) exit
- Turn right onto Haymaker Road
- Take the ramp to westbound I-376/Business Route 22

- Take the ramp to Penn Hills/northbound Route 791 (Exit 81)
- End detour

Rodi Road to Business Route 22 (William Penn Highway)

- Take westbound I-376 to the Churchill (Exit 79B) exit
- Turn left onto Beulah Road
- Turn left onto Churchill Road
- Turn left onto the ramp to eastbound I-376/Business Route 22
- Take the Monroeville/Business Route 22 (Exit 80) exit
- End detour

This work is part of the \$70.1 million I-376 Parkway East Betterment Project. Work will include a superstructure replacement over Old William Penn Highway, two bridge rehabilitations over Old William Penn Highway/Lougeay Road/Sunset Drive and Thompson Run Road/Thompson Run/Union Railroad, and six bridge preservations along the I-376. Throughout the project motorists can expect long-term single-lane restrictions, several weekends with traffic down to a single lane, and a long-term crossover in 2025. The improvements on the 4.5 miles of the Parkway East between the Churchill/Route 130 (Exit 79B) and Monroeville/Route 48 (Exit 84A) exit are anticipated to conclude in the fall 2026. Swank Construction Company, LLC is the prime contractor.
