The following list of electronics will **NOT** be accepted at **Goodwill Keystone Area** stores and donation centers.

- X Loose batteries

- X Smoke detectors
- X Hazardous household waste
- Freon-containing devices

- X Any devices containing mercury
- White goods: refrigerators, ranges, water heaters, freezers, unit air conditioners, washing machines, clothes dryers and other similar domestic and commercial large appliances
